3.Chairman's Report

The chairman thanked the Cllrs, clerk & Ward Cllr David Summers for their support throughout the last year. No visits to PC meetings from the local policing team during the year with little communication between the Police and PC.

The lengthsman was also thanked for his work to maintain the verges in the rural areas and designated grass cutting areas of the parish as well as undertaking ditch maintenance on behalf of the parish throughout the year.

It had been another difficult year regarding support from Herefordshire Council in relation to ongoing road issues that were not being addressed and enforcement of 7.5 weight tonne limit at Rotherwas Railway bridge.

4. Ward Cllr Annual report

The ward Cllr reported that the matter of getting potholes attended to in the parish was ongoing. The quality of the work when they were done was poor, and he was hoping that improvements would be made in due course.

Signage at Rotherwas Services station was being attended to and there had been reports of mini mokes using the cycleway, which had been brought to the attention of the police. The Ward Cllr proposed a meeting with the local policing team and the parish council to see what could be done to stop the riding of the mini mokes along the cycleway.
